## Current situation

The Salvatore clinic has been working from Monday to Friday, and patients come every day.

Guatemala has 430 cases to date, 30 have recovered, and 11 have died.

We have not had any cases of coronavirus in our clinic, only cases of diabetes, hypertension, pneumonia and others.

In Palín area, we don't have cases of coronavirus.

The effects of COVID 19 on the Guatemalan population are perceived in the economy, job losses and low sales for informal merchants. In the case of students, education has become remote, the problem is for students who do not have access to a computer, much less the internet.
